

**FLORENCE BRASSER MERIT SCHOLARSHIP FUND
POLICY AND PROCEDURES
UNITED METHODIST CHURCH OF NORTH CHILI
2017**

The Florence Brasser Merit Scholarship Fund has been established, and it is being made available to students from the families of United Methodist Church of North Chili in accordance with the following guidelines:

1. Scholarship grants may be made available each school year depending upon the availability of funds and will be dispersed at the discretion of the Leadership Team.
2. Each worthy and qualified student who applies for a scholarship grant will submit, as part of the application process, an essay about their future goals and educational plans.
3. This scholarship is for students who actively participate in the United Methodist Church of North Chili.
4. Each student applicant shall have completed high school, and shall be enrolled in a two -year or four – year college or university.
5. Continuing **eligibility for scholarship grants from this fund shall include the maintenance of a “C” average, or its equivalent grade point average**, for the school year prior to application for a scholarship grant.
6. Each student applicant shall submit a high school transcript, in addition to the formal application for a scholarship grant. The Scholarship Committee will consider grades, extra-curricular activities, and exhibited leadership qualities in the granting of awards. All scholarship grants shall be made by the Church Council of the United Methodist Church of North Chili in its sole discretion based upon applications and supporting information supplied by the student applicants. **A complete application must include a recent transcript.**
7. All applications for the scholarship grants for a school year shall be submitted to the Scholarship Fund Committee no later than August 17 of the calendar year in which funds are sought. No application shall be accepted after that date. Applications are available in the church office, and on our website: www.umcnorthchili.org.
8. Scholarship grants shall be made to the student and shall be paid early in the fall.
9. Further details concerning the Florence Brasser Merit Scholarship Fund may be obtained from members of the Church Council or the Pastor of the United Methodist Church of North Chili.
