



UMW at the Ronald McDonald House

On Wednesday May 22nd, six members of United Methodist Women met with groceries in hand to prepare a meal for the residents of our local Ronald McDonald House. Located at 333 Westmoreland Drive, three blocks from Golisano Children's Hospital.

We toured the house which offers 24 guest rooms with private baths, kitchen, family rooms, laundry facilities, meals and snacks, and shuttle services. The facility is open to parents, siblings and extended family of pediatric patients.

"There is a different atmosphere in the House when meals are provided. More people gather and become support for one another. It's nice for people to come "home" after a long day at the hospital, smell comforting aroma of a home-cooked meal and feel taken care of."

Groups sign up to provide a meal—either breakfast or dinner. We prepared a Chicken, rice and broccoli casserole, tossed salad, a mixed fruit salad and pudding parfaits. We spent about an hour and a half to prepare a meal for 40 people. A very rewarding experience!
